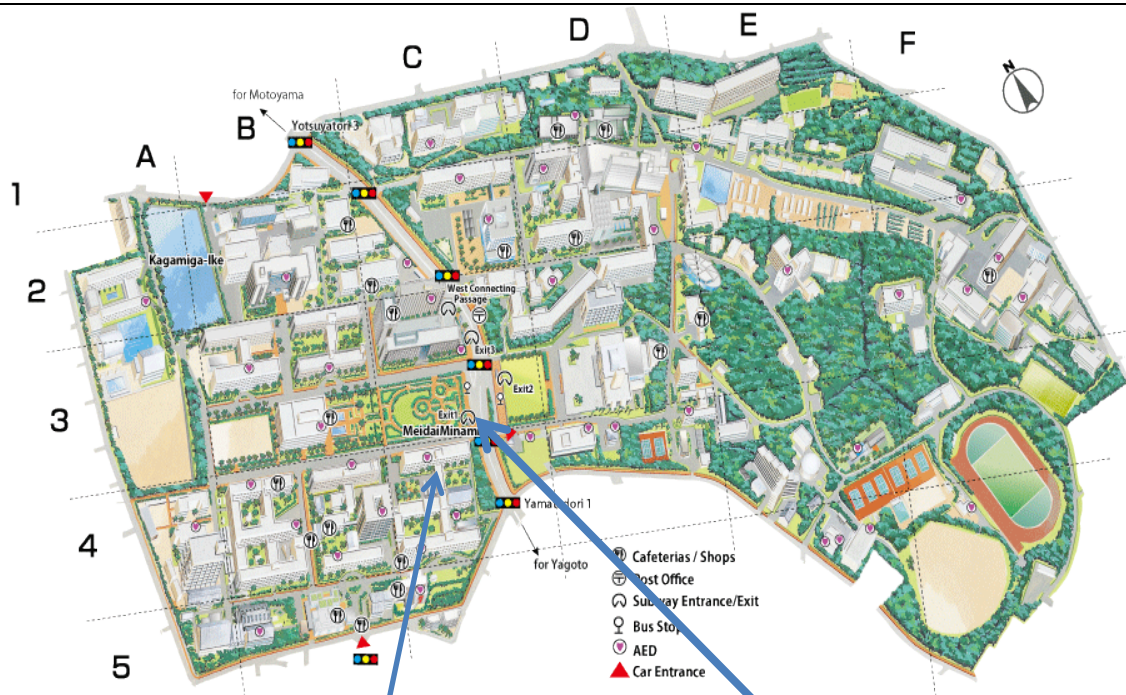

Transportation to Nagoya University



To the conference venue **School of Economics** Nagoya University (名古屋大学経済学部) **from Nagoya Garden Hotel**, go to the Sakae Subway Station (地下鉄栄駅) and take the Subway Higashiyama Line(東山線) to Motoyama Sta. (本山駅) (15 minutes). Then transfer to the Subway Meijo Line(名城線) to Nagoya Daigaku Station (名古屋大学駅). The School of Economics(経済学部) is just off the **subway exit 1** 出口 1).

From Nagoya Station: Take the Subway Higashiyama Line(東山線) to Motoyama Sta. (本山駅) (15 minutes), then transfer to the Subway Meijo Line(名城線) to Nagoya Daigaku Station (名古屋大学駅).
