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1. Message from the APMAA 2015 Conference Chairs

Trisakti University, University of Merdeka Malang, Udayana University, Warmadewa University, Hasanuddin University, and Mercu Buana University will host its 11th annual Asia Pacific Management Accounting Association (APMAA) Conference on October 26th –29th, 2015 in Bali, Indonesia.

“This conference is recognized as one of the top of management accounting conference,” said Prof. Grahita, professor of accounting at University of Merdeka Malang. She said: “We are going to have two days packed full of high-quality conference and will be preceded by Doctoral Colloquium. We encourage academicians and practitioners to take place in this conference. There will be around 100 overseas attendees to share issues, ideas, and empirical results in management accounting and other fields of accounting as well.”

Prof. Janek Ratnatunga, PhD, FCA, CMA, CPA

His previous appointments were Dean and Head of Commerce at the University of South Australia and Head of Department and Chair in Business Accounting at Monash University, Australia. He has been awarded the prestigious joint American Accounting Association, AICPA (USA), CIMA (UK) and CMA (Canada) Impact on Management Accounting Practice Award. The award is given annually to a paper published within the last five years in a referred academic journal that has the greatest potential impact on Management Accounting Practice.

Chairul Tanjung is a successful Indonesian businessman. He was the Coordinating Minister for Economics in the Indonesian cabinet in 2014. Now, he is the chairman and founder of CT Corp. along with the late founder of Sony, Akio Morita. 2. Call for Papers: 2015 Annual Conference

**2015 Annual Conference Theme:
Management Accounting For Sustainable Development
October 26th – 29th, 2015**

Venue: Udayana University and Warmadewa University, Bali, Indonesia

The general theme for this conference is “**Management Accounting for Sustainable Development.**” However, manuscripts may encompass any topical areas of **management accounting** and they can be theoretical, teaching-based or practice-oriented. Papers are welcomed in all of the following areas:

- Management Accounting and Control
- Management Accounting for Multinational Enterprises
- Management Accounting for State-owned Companies and Non-profit Organizations
- Management Accounting and Culture
- Financial Reporting
- Sustainability Reporting
- Integrated Reporting
- Shariah Accounting
- Internal control and Accountability: Professional and Business Ethics
- Corporate Governance
- Risk Management
- Intellectual Capital and Knowledge Management
- Social and Environmental Accounting
- Methodological and Theoretical Issues in Management Accounting
- Management Accounting Education
- Management Accounting History

It should be noted:

- Papers published elsewhere are not eligible for submission. Preference will be given to recent papers that have not previously been presented at major conferences.
- Papers will be double-blind reviewed. Author(s) of accepted papers must register for the conference. At least one of the main authors is required to register for the conference by October 1st 2015 and to present the work at the paralel session.

PAPER SUBMISSION

MANUSCRIPT FORMATTING

- All manuscripts should be in Times New Roman, font size 12, double-spaced with an abstract of 200-300 words. Include up to 5 keywords. **An abstract** should be presented on a separate page immediately preceding the text.
- Manuscripts should be as concise as the subject and research method permit. The length of text should be over **5,000 but not exceed 10,000 words**.
- All papers will be double-blind reviewed. To promote anonymous review, authors should not identify themselves directly or indirectly in their paper. Single authors should not use the editorial “we.” Referencing should follow the APA style (Refer to <http://www.apastyle.org>).
- The cover page should contain the title of the paper (all bold capitals), the author’s name (first name, initial(s), and family name), title and affiliation, fax and phone numbers, and email address.
- Please indicate clearly the corresponding author.

3. Call for Papers: 2015 Doctoral Colloquium

A Doctoral Colloquium will be held in conjunction with the **APMAA 2015** Annual Conference, which aims to offer an opportunity to PhD students to receive a high-quality feedback from external reviewers and to directly interact with peers, exchange ideas, discuss concepts, and establish (in) formal cooperation with various research groups. The discussants comprise of a group of international Professors.

Doctoral students and candidates are hereby invited to present and discuss their preliminary results or work-in-progress. Doctoral students and candidates at all stages are welcome to submit a thesis-position paper, but preference will be given to students in the earlier stages of their doctoral work. Students interested in participating in the doctoral

colloquium should submit a single PDF file consisting of:

1. An introductory letter in which you indicate what you wish to obtain from the doctoral colloquium and what you will be bringing to the doctoral colloquium.
2. A one page research statement on the research you will pursue. If you are at the doctoral dissertation stage, this statement should focus on the dissertation.
3. Your CV.
4. A letter of recommendation from your primary dissertation advisor, who should state what you can contribute as well as gain from the doctoral consortium.
5. Your paper (The text should be about 4,000- 8,000 words.)

Participants will be expected to give short and informal presentations of their work during the Colloquium, to be followed by a panel-like discussion. The submitted paper should clearly state:

The original key idea/hypothesis of the thesis
The problem domain and the specific problem addressed
An overview of related work in the area of the Doctoral work
Methodological approach
Research carried out
The expected contributions (in line with the field of study)

Paper Submission:

The deadline for **full paper submissions** is **July 15th, 2015**.

Since this is expected to be a work conducted by doctoral students, we require that:

The first author is a Doctoral student who is mainly responsible for conducting the research on the respective topic.

Names of the authors are preceded by: Student: and, where applicable, supervisor.

The colloquium chairs will arrange the selection of the accepted papers using a peer review process. The accepted papers will be published in the Doctoral Colloquium

proceedings. At least one of the authors must be registered (pay the participation fee) for the conference before the deadline of conference registration (**on September 25th, 2015**), and attend as well present the paper in the conference. Otherwise, the paper will not be included in the conference program and proceedings. Paper presented at the conference will be published in the USB proceedings of the conference.
