- 2. Accepted concept papers will be considered for publication in the conference proceeding.

Papers for the above publications are subject to peer review process and additional fee will apply for publication of accepted papers in indexed journals.

SUBMISSION

- Submission of papers should be in the form of MS Word format and typed in Times New Roman (12point) with double-spacing and should not be more than 5000 words. The name(s), address, contact number and email of the author(s) should be clearly stated on the first page.
- The abstract shall not exceed 200 words and should provide a statement of the purpose and procedures of the study, including
 major conclusions of the research. Figures, tables and references should also be on separate pages at the end of the text.
- Endnotes should be kept to a minimum.
- All abstracts/papers are to be submitted via ICFC 2022 website (Submit Abstract / Full papers) or https://cmt3.research.microsoft.com/ICFC2022
- All papers submitted to ICFC 2022 will be peer reviewed.
